Glass	Bottles and Jars Green, Clear & Brown	Remove Lids and Discard in Trash Rinse clean	Windows, Mirrors, Lightbulbs and Tubes, Pyrex and Dishes, Drinking Glasses, Chemical Bottles, Medical Containers, Laboratory Glass
Aluminum	Cans ONLY	Flattening Optional	Foil and Bottle Caps
Tin & Steel Cans	Food Cans ONLY	Flattening Optional Rinse clean	Cardboard Sides Juice Cans, Aerosol Cans, Paint Cans
Plastic	Plastic Bags, Milk, Soda and Detergent Bottles, Other Bottles Marked 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7 on the bottom.	Remove and Discard Lids in Trash Rinse clean	Styrofoam, Plastic Cups and Film, Hard Plastic (Toys, Pails, etc.) Medicine Bottles & Syringes
Newspapers, Magazines, Office Paper and Cardboard ONLY	What can be recycled? Newspapers, Magazines, Cardboard Card Stock, Office Paper, Books, Envelopes, Paper Other Examples: Brown Paper Tape, Computer Printouts, File Folders-Manila, Glued Pads, Tablets, Phone Books, Post-It Notes, and ANY Junk Mail	What <u>can't</u> be recycled? Bathroom Waste Paper (towels, toilet paper), Carbon Paper, Cellophane, Cloth, Cork, Foil, Polystyrene Styrofoam, anything Waxed, Candy Wrappers, Napkins, Paper Cups, Styrofoam Cups, Styrofoam Packaging, Paper Food Containers, Photographs, Fiberboard	

All trash items **MUST** be placed in plastic bags or containers no larger than 35 gallon cans

Trash items not accepted for disposal with your household trash:

- Hazardous Waste Materials
- Paints, chemicals, used motor oil or any liquids
- Tires, car batteries
- Asbestos Containing Material
- Yard waste or compost
- Construction or remodeling debris
- Tree stumps/limbs, stones, dirt
- Large appliances- small kitchen acceptable
- E-waste such as TV's, DVD/VCR players
- Furniture/mattresses
