Winter is here!

With winter's arrival, it's helpful to review village ordinances and policies important during cold-weather months. Here's a quick

STREET PARKING Overnight street parking during with winter months is allowed unless it snows. If it snows you may not park on the street and 24 hours after snowfall. In the event of extenuating circumstances leave a message at 920-992-5454. No overnight parking is allowed anytime during the year on Lincoln Avenue between Harvey and Rio Street. SNOW REMOVAL REMINDERS -- Please keep your side-walks clear of snow and ice to provide safe passage for everyone! The Village Board would like to remind residents and business owners that snow and ice MUST be removed from all sidewalks. According to Village Ordinance 6-2-8(a), property owners have 24 hours from the time snow ceases to accumulate to remove snow and ice from sidewalks that adjoin their property. Snow cleared from side-walks, driveways and parking lots cannot be shoveled, blown or plowed into the highway, street or any public right-ofway, where it poses a safety hazard to road crews, pedestrians and motorists. If you do not remove snow in a timely manner, the village will do it for you and bill you \$100 per hour, 1 hour minimum. Any portion beyond a full hour will be charged the full hourly rate. Each 24-hour period will be considered a separate offense and billed according to ordinance.

PLEASE LEND A HAND — clear snow from fire hydrants so firefighters have clear access to the hydrants in an emergency. POLLS OPEN at 7 am for the Spring Election on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. If a Primary Election is required it will be held on registered to vote in the Village of Rio, you may register in the Clerk's Office before the election, register online https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/ or at the polls the day of the election. VOTER PHOTO ID is required. Please remember to bring your photo id to the polls.

Dog Registration Required

DOG LICENSES expire on December 31 of each year...Wisconsin Stats. 174.05 requires

that all dogs over five (5) months of age be licensed. A current rabies vaccination is required at the time your license is obtained. Vaccination records are only needed if there is an update from last year or if this is a new animal to be licensed. The cost of a license \$7.00 for a neutered/spayed dog and \$12.00 for a not neutered/spayed dog. A \$5.00 late fee will be assessed to animals not licensed by April 1. A \$75.00 citation will be issued for unlicensed dogs after May 31. If you no longer have your dog, please let the Village Office know so we can update our records.

Rio Sewer and Water Rates -- January 1, 2024

Water Rates: The water utility's condition is reviewed annually by auditors and by the Public Service Commission (PSC). The PSC establishes the water rate structure. The last water rate increase was January 1, 2016. Sewer Rates: The increase will be in effect as of January 1, 2023 and the increase will be for per 1000 gallons used. The new rate will be \$6.50 per 1000 gallons for residents and \$8.13 for township residents (previously \$6.50 per 1000 gallons for Village or \$7.50 for the Township). The Sewer Utility is required to have 110 % debt coverage that is required from the Department of Revenue for the Financial Assistance Agreement for the Clean Water Loan the Sewer Utility has and has not been able to meet the requirement.
